Class I

Maths- Take 100 seeds of chickpeas (white chana) or kidney beans (rajma). Now take ten small bowls and put 10 seeds in every bowl. As shown in the picture □□□□□□□□□□ Once the bowls are filled with 10 seeds, practice

counting in tens. Like 10 , 20 ,30 and so on as the tenth bowl will be counted as 100.

Now write the numbers in tens both in figures and words eg :

a) 10-ten 20,30,40,50,60,70,80,90 and 100 one-hundred
